

CHAPTER 1: THE INDIAN HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM

The Indian Higher Education Landscape

The higher education system in India is one of the oldest and most agile systems in the world, featuring a blend of public and private universities. As of 2025, the country hosts over 1,000 universities, including 54 central, 416 state, 147 deemed, and 361 state private universities, alongside 159 Institutes of National Importance like the IITs and IIMs. The University Grants Commission (UGC) remains the primary governing body, enforcing standards and coordinating between central and state governments.

National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 Reforms The NEP 2020 has introduced transformative shifts in both school and college education.

- **Degree Structure:** It proposes a 4-year multidisciplinary bachelor's degree with multiple exit options: a certificate after one year, a diploma after two years, a regular degree after three years, and a degree with research or honors after four years.
- **National Digital University (NDU):** Launched to provide cost-effective, hub-and-spoke model access to standardized global education with national and international equivalency.
- **Professors of Practice:** The government is shifting curricula towards practical industry experience by allowing institutions to hire industry experts as professors.

- Admissions: Most colleges admit based on class 12 marks (merit); some may have entrance tests or interviews.
- Accreditation: Look for NAAC grading (A/A+) and program approvals for quality assurance.
- Campus life & placement support: Many colleges offer robust extra-curricular opportunities and industry exposure.

Note :

HOW TO USE RANKINGS

- Use rankings to shortlist but inspect **curriculum, placements, faculty, labs and accreditation**.
- Verify **NBA/NAAC** accreditation for program-level quality (NBA for engineering programs; NAAC for institutions).
- Visit campuses, talk to students and placement cells, check recent placement reports.

Cut-off Marks

There are **NO** single fixed “cut-off marks” for Engineering or Medical colleges because cut-offs depend on:

- Year (varies every year)
- Category (OC / BC / MBC / SC / ST)
- Quota (Government / Management)
- Exam type
 - Engineering → TNEA (12th Maths + Physics + Chemistry = 200)
 - Medical → NEET-UG (720 marks)
- Course & College (CSE vs Civil, MBBS vs BDS, etc.)
